Day Care Swimming Program

Our Day Care Swimming Program aims to provide support to busy families by providing swimming lessons to children from 3 years old as part of the weekly program at your Day Care Centre. Our qualified and experienced Swimming and Water Safety Teachers are committed to meeting the needs of all students through building trusting and caring relationships to enhance children's swimming ability, aquatic education and safety skills in aquatic environments.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where is the pool located?

Lessons will be provided at C-Me Swim School, situated at 70 Russell St Edge Hill.

Who does my child get to swimming lessons?

If your Centre does not have its own transport, our C-Me Swim Bus is provided. It is fitted with 12 Australian Standard Child Safety Seats and driven by our licensed driver and accompanied by a Day Care staff member. When your child arrives at C-Me Swim they are assisted off the bus and walked into our pool area where they are supervised and assisted to put on their cap and goggles (supplied). Our friendly teachers will then direct them into their assigned class. Their towels are on poolside for quick and easy access when they exit the pool to return to the bus.

Is the pool heated?

Yes - our C-Me Swim pool is heated year round and covered to keep children warm and sun-safe.

What does my child need to bring?

Swimmers and a towel (hooded ones are popular). Children are changed at the Day Care Centre and return wearing their swimmers and towel. Sterilised caps and goggles are supplied to reduce lost property and to be time efficient.



How much does it cost?

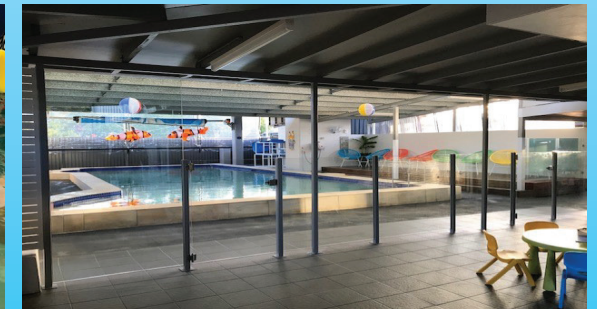
Each 10 week term coincides with the Queensland State School Terms and costs \$200. This payment is required at the beginning of the term directly to your Day Care Centre (or in arrangement with them). Students whom commence part way through the term will be charged on a pro rata basis of \$20/lesson. There is no charge for Public Holidays.

How many children are in a class?

Primarily we work on a 1:4 ratio however children are grouped as per their ability and class sizes may be adjusted accordingly.

What if my child is sick?

No make up lessons are included in our Day Care Swimming Program, if a child is sick they will miss the lesson. Special circumstances may arise which will be assessed on an individual basis.



What will my child learn?

Each child is assessed at the beginning of their first lesson and then they are allocated into the most appropriate class. We pride ourselves on recognising the different learning styles of all our swimmers. Group dynamics, physical, social and emotional development together with varying teaching styles will all influence the routine and pedagogy of each lesson. There is no one recipe for teaching children to swim. At C-Me Swim our lessons are purposefully designed to best suit the learning needs of our swimmers.

Learning to Swim is a very complex skill that requires time and commitment also patience, trust and understanding from our parents. If your child has had any negative water experiences or you are a non/weak swimmer yourself, please notify us.

Parents are welcome to pop in or to watch their child's lesson. We have pool side seating and an airconditioned viewing room.
